### *Medicare Application Assistance Clinics*

The ADRC has partnered with the Sister Bay/Liberty Grove Library branch for individuals in northern Door County to access in-person guidance and support closer to home with their Medicare applications. The ADRC coordinates a group of SHIP counselors (State Health Insurance Program) who are trained volunteers to help others understand Medicare in an unbiased way. They are available for appointments to answer questions and help with entering and submitting Medicare applications.

## Lake Michigan Lake Levels

Forecasted water levels for October 25th are 4 to 9 inches below last month's levels and range from 3 to 8 inches below levels from last year on all lakes. Projected October 25th levels are below their long-term average October levels on Lakes Superior, Michigan-Huron, and Ontario, by 8 inches, 4 inches, and 4 inches, respectively. Lakes St. Clair and Erie are above their October average levels by 4 and 7 inches, respectively. The lakes are in their period of seasonal decline and are forecast to continue their declines in the coming month. By November 25th, water levels are forecast to decline on Lakes Superior and Michigan-Huron by 2 inches, Lakes St. Clair and Erie are forecast to drop by about 4 inches, and Lake Ontario is forecast to drop 3 inches.
