Saturday August 23rd 12-7pm Blues on the Bay



Lake Michigan Lake Levels

Forecasted July 25th water levels on Lakes Superior and Michigan-Huron are 4 and 2 inches above levels from a month ago, respectively. Lakes St. Clair, Erie, and Ontario levels range from 2 to 4 inches below last month's levels. Lakes Superior and Michigan-Huron, St. Clair, and Erie are below their water levels from a year ago by 2, 9, 10, and 7, inches, respectively, whereas Lake Ontario's level is about the same. Lakes Superior and Michigan-Huron are both below their long-term monthly averages for July by 3 to 4 inches. Lakes St. Clair and Erie levels are 2 and 3 inches above long-term average July levels, respectively, while Lake Ontario's July 25th level is at its long-term average. All lakes remain well below record high levels and well above record low levels for July. Lake Superior is expected to rise 1 inch over the next month, while Lakes Michigan-Huron, St. Clair, Erie, and Ontario are expected to begin their seasonal declines and decrease by 1, 2, 4, and 3 inches, respectively.
