## **NWTC Community Education Classes**



## **Lake Michigan Lake Levels**

Forecasted water levels for August 22<sup>nd</sup> on Lakes Michigan-Huron, St. Clair, Erie, and Ontario are 2, 2, 3, and 6 inches below last month's levels, respectively, while Lake Superior is 2 inches above last month's level. Lakes Michigan-Huron, St. Clair, and Erie are below their water levels from a year ago by 6 to 8 inches, while Lakes Superior and Ontario are within 1 to 2 inches of their levels from a year ago. Lakes St. Clair and Erie are above their long-term average August levels by 3 inches, while Lakes Superior and Michigan-Huron are 2 and 5 inches below their long-term average August levels, respectively. Lake Ontario is about an inch below its August average level. All lakes remain well below record high levels and well above record low levels for August. By September 22<sup>nd</sup>, Lake Superior is expected to be near its current level, while Lakes Michigan-Huron, St. Clair, Erie, and Ontario are expected to decline by 2, 4, 4, and 3 inches, respectively.
