

TOWN OF LYNDON  
Adoption of the Town Tax Levy at Special Town Meeting of the Electors

**WHEREAS**, s. 60.10(1)(A) of the Wis. Statutes authorizes the town electors of a town to adopt the town tax levy at a town meeting of the electors, and

**WHEREAS**, a special town meeting of the electors has been called for this 12<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2025, and

**NOW THEREFORE**, the special town meeting of the Town of Lyndon, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors duly assembled and voting resolves and orders as follows:

**BE IT RESOLVED**, the town electors of the Town of Lyndon, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, hereby adopt the town tax levy for 2025 to be collected in 2026 at \$ 575,928.

*The town clerk shall properly post this resolution in three places as required by law under s. 60.80 of Wis. States within 30 days of the below noted adoption date.*
