



The Sheboygan County Connect program is here to help rural residents of Sheboygan County with transportation to supermarkets, grocery stores, and pharmacies with ease! Whether you are stocking up on essentials or picking up prescriptions, this service provides affordable transportation to meet your needs. Shopping trips are offered with 60- or 90- minute appointment windows, so you have plenty of time to get what you need. Fares are based on the distance between your home and your destination, ranging from \$3 to \$7 for a one-way trip. Round-trip fares are double the one-way fare. The fare amount will be discussed when scheduling your ride. We offer an online payment option as well as accepting payment when you enter the vehicle. To use the Sheboygan County Connect program, riders must be in one of the following populations: a veteran, 60 years or older, or between 18-59 with a qualifying disability. Riders should be able to get in and out of a minivan independently and carry their own groceries, but don't worry—a small rolling cart will be provided to help get your bags to your door.
