ORDINANCE NO. 56

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT OUTDOOR SOLID FUEL HEATING DEVICES IN DEFINED AREAS

The Town Board of the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County, Wisconsin DO ORDAIN as follows:

Ordinance No. 56 shall be created to read as follows:

Section 1: Definition. Includes an accessory structure or appliance designed for a location ordinarily outside the principal structure and used to transfer or provide heat via liquid or other means, by burning wood or other solid fuels, for heating any principal or accessory structure on the premises. Does not include recreational fire, barbecues, fryers or chimneys, or other outdoor burning.

Section 2: Prohibited. Installation and operation of outdoor solid fuel heating devices is prohibited entirely within the Town of Oakland Urban Service Area as defined in the Comprehensive Growth Plan for the Town of Oakland, and within 600 feet of a neighboring residence in any other area in the Town of Oakland.

Section 3: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication or posted as required by law.
