## IMPLEMENTS OF HUSBANDRY (IoH) AGRICULTURAL COMMERCIAL VEHICLES (Ag CMV)

## Please Take Note:

Per WI State Statute 86.02, Injury to highway. Any person who shall injure any highway by obstructing or diverting any creek or watercourse or sluiceway, or by dragging logs or timber thereon, or by any other act, shall be liable in treble damages, to be recovered by the political division chargeable with the maintenance of highway injured, and the amount recovered shall be credited to the highway maintenance fund.

• Complete the appropriate No-Fee Permit Application from the WI Department of Transportation as it pertains to your type of equipment:

MV2582 - No Fee Permit Application for IoH

Or

MV2583 - No Fee Permit Application for Ag CMV

- Once application is made to the Roads Manager, it may take up to 3 weeks for approval or denial of the permit
- Approved permits will be good for one year but can be renewed annually after the first year of submission for subsequent calendar years
- If you obtain a new piece of equipment during the year, you may request an amendment to your current application by contacting the Roads Manager
- Once amendment request is submitted to the Roads Manager it may take up to five days for approval or denial
