

#### **Township Elections Held March 12th**

Election polls are open 5PM until 8PM at the Ogema Town Hall. Residents will be voting to fill one supervisor (3 year term) and one clerk (2 year term).

#### Not in town for March Elections?

There are several ways to vote absentee early. Contact the township clerk (320-284-6110). You can vote through the mail, or in person at the Town Hall which is open on Saturday March 9th 10AM—12PM before the election.

#### **Pine County Offers Well Water Testing**

Pine County has resumed well water testing. Residents and business owners desiring well water analysis are invited to pickup a sampling kit at the Pine County Planning and Zoning office during business hours (M-F 8AM-4:30PM.

#### **Pine County Recycling Centers**

Recycling centers are located in Sandstone, Willow River and Pine City. Staff is on-site during hours of operations to assist with any questions on recycling and disposal.

#### **Winter Snowplowing**

A winter reminder to not push snow across the road when plowing your driveway. It is unlawful in the State of Minnesota and property owners can be held liable for any damage or injuries.

#### **Township Happenings**

In 2021 and 2022, Ogema received \$38,358 in funding from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). Those funds help cover many general government expenses during the pandemic. With those funds Ogema was able to cover payroll, purchase an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) device, now mounted in the town hall, and take care of much needed town hall and cemetery renovations.

Did you know that the Ogema township is a member of the **Pine County Area Hospital** district? Hospital districts were created by the state legislature in 1986 with the idea that townships and cities could form a district to provide access to quality healthcare in rural Minnesota. The Gateway clinic in Hinckley is currently being renovated and is expected to reopen in mid-2024.
