

CITY OF PELICAN RAPIDS COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES-01-18-02

The City Council of Pelican Rapids met in regular session in a continued meeting from 01-14-02. Council met on Friday, 01-18-02, at 1:00 p.m., in the City Clerk's Office, City Hall. Mayor Wayne Runningen, Council Members Paulette Nettetstad, Denise Magnusson and John Waller III were present. City Clerk Richard A. Meeting called to order by Mayor Wayne Runningen.
