From the Village Hall

Yard Waste: Such as grass clippings, leaves, and yard & garden waste shall be disposed of by composting the material or taking it to the Village compost site.

Littering Streets Prohibited: No person shall place, throw, deposit, dump, scatter, leave or permit to remain any rubbish, paper, stone, wire, manure, snow, ice, dirt, grass, leaves, construction or yard waste, dirt or filthy substance upon the street, gutter, sidewalk, alley or public ground in the village. Each owner or occupant of any building, dwelling house, store, shop, tenement or structure of any kind and description fronting or abutting on any street, sidewalk, gutter, alley or public ground shall clean the same by sweeping, scraping or shoveling such rubbish, dirt or filth from the sidewalk by or before twelve o'clock (12:00) noon of each day, and shall cooperate with the street commissioner in keeping the streets, alleys, gutters and public grounds in a clean, tidy and orderly manner.

Operator Licenses: Some Operator Licenses expire at midnight on June 30th. Please look at your license to see when it expires. If you need to renew your license, a fill-in application can be found on the Reedsville Website at www.reedsvillewi.gov under the Forms & Permits tab or picked up at the Reedsville Municipal Building lobby. **You must submit a copy of your driver's license with the application.** Cost of the license is \$25.00 for renewals and \$32.00 for new applicants. This is a 2-year license.

Pool Owners: You must fill out the Swimming Pool Discount Application to qualify for the swimming pool discount. No other form of submittal will be accepted. A fill-in application can be found on the Reedsville Website at www.reedsvillewi.gov under the Forms & Permits tab or picked up at the Reedsville Municipal Building Lobby.

Village Board Meeting Minutes

Thursday April 14, 2022

6:30 pm

1. Call to order

The monthly meeting of the Reedsville Village Board was called to order on April 14, 2022 at 6:30 PM by Village Trustee Jack Siebert.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

4. Approval of Agenda

A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Rataichek to amend the agenda to move the discussion/possible decision on the Village President to the end of the meeting. Motion carried 3-1 (Be Busse opposed).

6. Approval of Minutes

a. A motion was made by Rataichek and seconded by Hansen to approve the March 3, 2022 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried 3-0 (Be Busse abstained)

b. A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Rataichek to approve the March 9, 2022 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

c. A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Rataichek to approve the March 17, 2022 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

d. A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Be Busse to approve the March 24, 2022 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

e. A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Rataichek to approve the March 31, 2022 meeting minutes as presented.

f. A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Be Busse to approve the April 4, 2022 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

b. A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Be Busse to approve the Special Law Enforcement Agreement with the City of Brillion in the amount of \$29,685.00. Motion carried 4-0.

c. Correspondence was presented from the Reedsville School District regarding the Hardball Field.

Fire Chief Jason Schuh submitted a written report.

2. First Responders

First Responders President, Mike Kocourek submitted a written report.

i. A motion was made by Rataichek and seconded by Be Busse to accept the resignation from Rey Kubik. Motion carried 4-0.

3. Utility Department

Utility Operator, Tanner Raddatz submitted a written report.

i. A motion was made by Rataichek and seconded by Be Busse to pay \$100.00 for temporary weekend duty. Motion carried 4-0.

ii. A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Rataichek to approve the proposal from Crane Engineering to replace the sanitary pump at the Manitowoc Street Lift Station in the amount of \$9,824.00. Motion carried 4-0.

iii. A motion was made by Rataichek and seconded by Hansen to approve the proposal from Crane Engineering to repair the wet well pump rails at the Wastewater Treatment Facility in the amount of \$5,298.00.

iv. A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Rataichek to approve the Profession Service Agreement for the Well #3 Design from Ayres Assoc in the amount of \$110,300.00. Motion carried 4-0.

v. The discussion/possible decision on the SDWL application was tabled.

4. Public Works

John Schuh, DPW submitted a written report.

i. The playground equipment at the Firemen's Park will be painted green.

ii. Hansen will look for tires for the payloader

iii. Siebert requested the sizes of the directional signs

iv. The discussion/possible decision on the Amendment to the Owner-Engineer Agreement was postponed until the April 21st, 2022 special meeting.

v. The draft of the Developers Ordinance will be forwarded to the Village Attorney for their review.

i. A motion was made by Be Busse and seconded by Rataichek to approve the rezoning request from Ray and Suzanne Bubolz for the Town View Estates. Motion carried 4-0.

ii. The discussion/possible decision on Resolution 2022-2, Resolution 2022-3, and Ordinance 2022-2 were postponed until the April 21, 2022 special meeting.

iii. A motion was made by Be Busse and seconded by Hansen to approve the Certified Survey Map from JB Reedsville was approved as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

6. Police Department

Police Chief, Kirk Schend, submitted was written report.

7. President Report

i. A motion was made by Rataichek and seconded by Hansen to appoint Jesse Walt as the Village President for the remainder of Village President term. Motion carried 4-1 (Be Busse - nay)

ii. A special meeting will be scheduled for April 21, 2022 at 6:30 pm

10. Upcoming Meetings: The next regular monthly meeting will be held on Thursday, May 12, 2022 at 6:30 pm.

11. Adjournment: A motion was made by Rataichek and seconded by Hansen to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 5-0. Meeting adjourned at 8:42 PM.
