## From the Village Hall

**Solid Waste & Recycling Carts** need to be out on the curb by 5:00 am for service. Carts need to be on separate sides of your driveway or at least 4' apart. DO NOT place carts within 4' ft of any objects such as utility poles, mailboxes, or vehicles. Carts placed on the street or on snow banks will not be serviced.

**Winter Parking Restrictions:** No person shall park any vehicle on any street or alley in the Village between two-thirty (2:30) am to six (6) am of any day from **November 1 to April 1**, unless permission to do so is received from the police department.

**Littering Streets Prohibited:** No person shall place, throw, deposit dump, scatter, leave or permit to remain any rubbish, paper, stone, wire, manure, snow, ice, dirt, grass, leaves, construction or yard waster, dirt or filthy substance upon the street, gutter, sidewalk, alley or public ground in the village.

**Sump Pumps:** No discharge or overflow of storm water shall be permitted upon any street or public way from **November 1** to April 1 of each year.

**November Election:** There will be a general election on **Tuesday, November 8th** for Governor/Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State, State Treasurer, United States Senator, Representative in Congress – District 6, State Senator, Representative to the Assembly - District 25, Manitowoc County Sheriff, Manitowoc County Coroner and Manitowoc County Clerk of Circuit Court. Polls will be open at the Reedsville Municipal Building, 217 Menasha St., from 7:00 am until 8:00 pm. You must show an acceptable form of photo identification to receive a ballot. To ensure you are properly registered or to apply for an absentee ballot, please visit [myvote.wi.gov](http://myvote.wi.gov)

**Voter Registration Forms in the Mail:** 2022 is a Governor Election year, which means you will soon be finding voter registration forms and absentee ballot request forms in your mailbox. **These mailings are not from your municipal clerk**, even though they may appear to be. They are sent by special interest groups and the prefilled voter information on the forms is often inaccurate.

A motion was made by Siebert and seconded by Hansen to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

#### c. Public Works/Utility Department

DPW, Jason Maertz, submitted a written report

i. The plans for the pilot testing and Facility Plan has been forwarded to the Dept. of Natural Resources for review.

ii. A special meeting has been scheduled for September 22, 2022 at 6:30pm to work on the Well #3 Water Treatment and Transmission Main Project

iii. The results from the Compliance Maintenance Report was presented for review

iv. The simplified water rate application will not be submitted at this time.

v. Tools will be submitted to the USDA for possible grant payment

vi. A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Fox to go with Collins State Bank for the 5 year loan at 4.4% with quarterly payments in the amount of \$46,042.40 starting December 1, 2022. Motion carried 4-0.

vii. Discussion on the hardball field will be postponed until the next regular scheduled Village Board meeting.

viii. A motion was made by Fox and seconded by Hansen to reimburse employees who use their personal phone \$40.00 a month. Motion carried 4-0.

ix. Discussion on street parking was postponed until the next regular scheduled Village Board meeting.

x. The Reedsville Fire Fighters will be purchasing some new playground equipment for the Firemen's Park. The Village employees will assist in construction of this equipment.

xi. More estimates will be obtained on directional signs.

xii. Discussion on the selling of unused equipment/items will be postponed until the next regular scheduled Village Board meeting.

#### d. Clerk-Treasurer — Mary Jo Krahn

i. The computer replacement will be submitted to the USDA for possible grant payment.

ii. A motion was made by Fox and seconded by Siebert to have Trick or Treating on Sunday, October 30th, 2022 from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm. Motion carried 4-0.

iii. The information on tourist lodging will be e-mail to the Village Board members for review for the next regular scheduled Village Board meeting.

iv. A special meeting to work on the 2023 proposed budgets was scheduled for October 6, 2022 at 6:30pm.

#### e. President Report — Jesse Walt

i. A motion was made by Fox and seconded by Maertz to appoint Bobbi Reedy to the vacant Village Board position. Motion carried 4-0.

ii. Following a discussion, a motion was made by Siebert and seconded by Maertz to deny Goeke's request to bring a trailer. Motion carried 3-2 (nay Siebert, Maertz, and Walt)

iii. Fox gave an update on the Small Community Form. Stiefvater will assist her in the planning of the event.

#### f. Police Department

Police Chief, Kirk Schend, submitted was written report.

10. At 8:25 pm a motion was made by Siebert and seconded by Fox to convene into **CLOSED Session**, pursuant to WI Statute Section 19.85(1)(f) to conduct business which requires a closed session to consider data of specific persons. Motion carried 4-0.

11. At 8:50 pm a motion was made by Siebert and seconded by Fox to reconvene into **OPEN Session**. Motion carried 4-0.

12. Walt and Ja Maertz will review the specs on the property involved

13. Upcoming Meetings: The next regular monthly meeting will be held on Thursday, October 13, 2022 at 6:30pm.

14. **Adjournment:** A motion was made by Fox and seconded by Siebert to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:00pm
