Dogs or Cats: It shall be unlawful to own, harbor, shelter, or keep any dog or cat which runs at large within the limits of the Village. A dog or cat shall be deemed to be running at large when it is on any public street, alley, parks or other grounds of the Village or any other premises in the Village other than the premises of its owner, his servant, agent or a member of his family of suitable age and discretion unless it is on a durable leash no longer than eight feet (8') or the dog or cat must be under control and within eight feet (8') of its owner, his servant, agent or a member of his family of suitable age and discretion at all times when off the premises of its owner.

It shall be unlawful for any person owning or in control of a dog or cat to allow or permit such animal to defecate on any private or public property owned by another unless such person shall remove all feces so deposited by such animal. Violation shall be punishable by a forfeiture of not less than twenty dollars (\$20.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00).

#### **Payment of Property Taxes:**

- Real estate and personal property tax payments can be made in person at the Reedsville Municipal Building during normal business hours.
- Payments may also be made by sending a check to the following: Reedsville Municipal Building, Tax Collection, 217
   Menasha St., Reedsville, WI 54230. Taxes paid by check or money order must be made payable to the Village of Reedsville. Cash will not be accepted. A receipt will only be sent back if you have included a self-addressed stamped envelope.

All first installment taxes are due by January 31st.

Solid Waste & Recycling Carts: Need to be out to the curb by 5:00am for service. DO NOT place carts within 4ft of any objects such as utility poles, mailboxes, or vehicles. Carts need to be on separate sides of your driveway or at least 4ft apart. Carts placed on the street or on snow banks will not be serviced.

<u>Cat & Dog Licenses:</u> Unspayed females and unneutered males are \$15.00 each. Spayed females and neutered males are \$10.00 each. You must show proof of a valid rabies shot. Please make out separate check for the licenses as it goes into a different account.

v. A motion was made by Siebert and seconded by Reedy to submit the pay request #7 to the USDA for the amount of \$11,116.86. Motion carried 6-0.

#### 4. Clerk-Treasurer — Mary Jo Krahn

i. A motion was made by Reedy and seconded by Rataichek to not include the Act 175 in the Floodplain Ordinance. Motion carried 5-0 (Maertz abstained).

**ii.** A motion was made by Rataichek and seconded by Fox to approve the operator's license application for Barbara Jacquart. Motion carried 6-0.

**iii.** Ordinance 2022-4 was introduced by Rataichek, a motion was made by Siebert and seconded by Hansen to amend pet fees. Motion carried 6-0.

iv. A motion was made by Maertz and seconded by Hansen to submit an application for a simplified rate case. Motion carried 6-0.

v. A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Fox to increase sewer rates by 6% for each quarter in 2023. Motion carried 6-0.

vi. A motion was made by Maertz and seconded by Fox to send and itemized bill with interest for unpaid lawn cutting bills. Motion carried 6-0.

vii. Discussion on fee schedule will be postponed until the next regular scheduled meeting.

#### 5. President Report — Jesse Walt

i. A motion was made by Rataichek and seconded by Reedy to approve the 2023 Valders Ambulance Service Agreement in the amount of \$38,176.00. Motion carried 6-0.

**ii.** A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Fox to approve the property owner to continue to have chickens on their property. Motion carried 6-0.

#### 6. Police Department

Police Chief, Kirk Schend, submitted was written report.

i. A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Fox to table the discussion on street parking until the next regular scheduled monthly meeting in February.

Motion carried 6-0.
