Thank You! On behalf of the citizens of the Village and the Village Board, we would like to say thank you to Al Schreiber for his many years of service as Village President.

Building Identification Number: The owner of every principal structure on each lot in the village shall have displayed on the side of the structure facing the adjoining public right of way numbers not less than four inches (4") in height showing the street number assigned to that property by the village. Numbers in script shall not meet the requirements of this section. The owner of such structure shall keep the numbers clear and unobstructed so that they can be readily seen by a person of ordinary eyesight from the adjoining public right of way.

Bicycle Registration: All bicycles must be registered. To obtain the license, flag down a Village Police Officer. A \$2.00 fee covers a one-time registration.

Board of Review: The Village of Reedsville will hold its Board of Review on Wednesday, May 14, 2025 from 3:30 pm to 5:30 pm in the hall at the Reedsville Municipal Building located at 217 Menasha Street. Please contact the Clerk-Treasurer at 754-4371 for the procedural requirements if you would like to appear before the Board.

Curfew: Any person under the age of 18 unaccompanied by a parent or legal guardian may not be out and about between 11:00 PM - 6:00 AM Sunday through Thursday and 12:00 PM - 6:00 AM Friday and Saturday.

Vehicle Nuisance: It is illegal for any partially dismantled, non-operating, wrecked, junked, unregistered or discarded vehicles to be placed or stored on any public or private property within the Village limits for a period of longer than five (5) days, unless said vehicles are stored within an enclosed building. This ordinance does not apply to property zoned for the sale or repair of vehicles. Having a vehicle behind your garage or under a tarp does not meet the requirement of an enclosed building.

Open Burning/Fire Pits: Controlled burning must be located off the public street pavement or street gutter, must be at least fifteen (15') from any lot line and may not be less than fifteen feet (15') from any building. Only clean wood may be used in fire pits and flames cannot extend more than two feet (2') above the pit. All fires must be monitored by a responsible person until the fire has extinguished itself completely. Persons utilizing and maintaining outdoor fires shall be responsible for any liability resulting from any damage caused by their fire.

Pool Owners: You must fill out the **Swimming Pool Discount Application** to qualify for the swimming pool discount. No other form of submittal will be accepted. This form can be found on the Reedsville website www.reedsvillewi.gov or picked up at the Reedsville Municipal Building Lobby. This also is for pressure washing your deck, watering lawns, gardens, etc. if you have any questions, please call the office (920) 754-4371.

Dogs or Cats: It shall be unlawful to own, harbor, shelter, or keep any dog or cat which runs at large within the limits of the Village. A dog or cat shall be deemed to be running at large when it is on any public street, alley, parks, or other grounds of the Village or any other premises in the Village other than the premises of its owner, his servant, agent or a member of his family of suitable age and discretion unless it is on a durable leash no longer than eight feet (8') or the dog or cat must be under control and within eight feet (8') of its owner, his servant, agent or a member of his family of suitable age and discretion at all times when off the premises of its owner.

It shall be unlawful for any person owning or in control of a dog or cat to allow or permit such animal to defecate on any private or public property owned by another unless such person shall remove all feces so deposited by such animal. Violation shall be punishable by a forfeiture of not less than twenty dollars (\$20.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00).

Littering Streets Prohibited: No person shall place, throw, deposit, dump, scatter, leave or permit to remain any rubbish, paper, stone, wire, manure, snow, ice, dirt, grass, leaves, construction or yard waste, dirt or filthy substance upon the street, gutter, sidewalk, alley or public ground in the village. Each owner or occupant of any building, dwelling house, store, shop, tenement or structure of any kind and description fronting or abutting on any street, sidewalk, gutter, alley or public ground shall clean the same by sweeping, scraping or shoveling such rubbish, dirt or filth from the sidewalk by or before twelve o'clock (12:00) noon of each day, and shall cooperate with the street commissioner in keeping the streets, alleys, gutters and public grounds in a clean, tidy and orderly manner.

Signs and Awnings: No signs, posters or other advertising material shall be placed in or on any village owned

 - The monthly meeting of the Reedsville Village Board was called to order on Monday, March 10, 2025, at 6:00PM by Village President Al Schreiber.

iv. Discussion was held regarding the solar power to sign on Hwy 10/W with updates from Ja Maertz on pricing.

- At 7:40 PM, a motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Siebert to convene into **CLOSED SESSION**, pursuant to WI Statute Section 19.85(1)(c) to conduct business which requires a closed session to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility. Closed session is in regards to employee performance evaluation regarding Village Clerk/Treasurer. A decision was made to have a Special Meeting. Motion carried 6-0.
- At 8:21 PM, a motion was made by Siebert and seconded by Fox to reconvene into **OPEN SESSION**. Motion carried 6-0.
- At 8: 25 PM, a motion was made by Fox and Hansen to convene into **CLOSED SESSION**, pursuant to WI State Sec 19.85 (1)(e) for deliberating or negotiating the purchase of public properties, the investing of public funds or conducting other specified public business whenever competitive or bargaining reasons requires a closed session. Closed session is in regards to the Fire Department. No decision was made. Motion carried 6-0.
- A motion was made by Hansen and Fox to reconvene into **OPEN SESSION**. Motion carried 6-0.
- A motion was made by Siebert and seconded by Hansen to convene into **CLOSED SESSION**, pursuant to WI State Sec 19.85 (1)(f) considering financial, medical, or social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons, preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific person which if discussed in public would likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data or involved in such problems or investigations.
