## **RESOLUTION 2025-01**

Resolution 2025-01 "Resolution to Reduce Number of Election Workers"

WHEREAS, Section 7.30 of Wis. Statutes, allows a municipal governing body to reduce the required number of election officials at a polling place from [7 or 5 (in a municipality where voting machines are used)].

WHEREAS Section 7.32 of Wis. Statutes states: Notwithstanding s. 7.30 (1) (a), the governing body or board of election commissioners of any municipality may by resolution reduce the number of election officials and modify or rescind any similar previous action. No such action may reduce the number of officials at a polling place to less than 3.

NOW, THERE FOR BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Richfield has determined that it would be advantageous to the Town of Richfield, currently using Election Systems & Software (ES&S) Express Vote Universal Voting System and the DS200 Poll Place Scanner and Tabulator equipment, to have only as many election officials on duty as are needed for a given election.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Richfield, Adams County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board, on a roll call vote, with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and declares as follows:

"There shall be a minimum of 3 election officials on duty at every election. At the discretion of the town clerk, the requisite number of election officials may be increased for any election. However, the number of election officials working at a given election shall always be an odd number no less than 3."

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
