**Discussion/approval of Electric Pump Proposal for \$5,460.00 to replace the Ethernet Cable at the WWTP.**

EQ Basin to Clearas Building is not talking at all so we must manually control this. This cable is cracked and is a normal cable that you would see in an office building. They are looking to put in more industrial cable that will go into a conduit but there is still a little exposure. This is a more rubberized cable made for outdoors. Motion to approve Electric Pump proposal to replace the ethernet cable by Vogt, seconded by Shemon. Motion carried.

**Discussion/action regarding Semi Parking on Village Streets and adjusting the citation fees for this.**

Johnson has a question regarding whether a semi can park on the street by him to visit and it cannot which was already in our ordinance. This is intended to deal with long-term parking issues. Still writing tickets but this will hopefully get word around that we are not cheap. Motion to approve with the minor change in the wording by Vogt, seconded by Beal. Discussion continued with Johnson asking what the fine was going to be and it will go to \$150. Motion to amend the original motion to increase the semi-parking fee to \$200 by Vogt, seconded by Beal. Motion carried.
