Water bill payments may be placed in the silver drop box located at the Village Hall right next to the U.S. Postal mailbox, in person during our office hours listed above or mail to us. Methods of payment are cash, check or money order. You may also pay online through our website at [rockdaleillinois.org](https://rockdaleillinois.org/) by using your account number to pull up your bill.

Garbage pickup is on Wednesdays unless it's a holiday, then it will be picked up the next day. You can visit Lakeshore Recycling & Disposal formerly Environmental Services website for additional information:

Yard Waste pickup is on Mondays (by our Public Works Department) unless it's a holiday, then it will be picked up the next business day and is from April through the end of November. Acceptable yard waste must be in a 30 gal paper bag. (5) Bags can be set out for pick up no sooner than 2 days prior to pick up.

Branches and twigs must be bundled and tied approximately 30 lbs and 3 ft long bundles.

Recycling is done at the Village Hall by using the huge Environmental Services container. It is emptied on Tuesdays and Fridays each week.

Property Maintenance. Owners and occupants are responsible for maintenance, upkeep and repair of the property.

Burning is permitted from October 1 to December 1.

Pavilion Reservations are for residents only and water bill must be in good standing.

Wild life/Critter removal for Village residents; contact the Joliet Township Animal Control at 815 725 0333.

ComEd street light out; contact the Village Hall with the pole number or location and we can send through a work order form to ComEd.

Dogs cannot run at large and must be on a leash. They also need to where ID tag stating the name, address and telephone number of the owner and a rabies tag.

Parking on street after 2" of snowfall. After 2" of snowfall, parking is allowed on even sides of the street on even calendar days and odd sides of the street on odd calendar days.
