<u>SCRAP METAL</u> - NO rusted burn barrels, woven or barbed wire, fuel tanks or wood is allowed in the scrap metal area. No large parts, vehicle toppers or trailers. Any large items shall be disposed of at local scrap yards. <u>If in doubt, ASK!</u>

COMINGLE RECYCLE: CARDBOARD, GLASS, PLASTIC, TIN

CARDBOARD: Flatten boxes and cut to 3-foot x 3-foot pieces. Do not bundle or tie.

GLASS BOTTLES/JARS: Accept food and beverage gloss bottles and jars only. Remove caps and lids and discard. Place glass in the designated bin. Do not accept auto glass, window glass, light bulbs or ceramics.

PLASTIC BOTTLES & CONTAINERS: Accept all plastic bottles, jugs and containers. Rinse and replace plastic caps and lids. Discard **plastic containers used for anti-freeze, fuel or motor oil in the trash compactor.**

STEEL & TIN CANS: Rinse all food and beverage cans. No need to remove the label.

NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES AND MIXED PAPER: Place magazines, pop and beer cases, cereal boxes and mixed paper in any bin. Do not bundle and tie.

SHARPS - DO NOT DISPOSE OF SHARPS WITH YOUR GARBAGE OR RECYCLING!!!

Dispose of your sealed and labeled sharps container at Aspirus Riverview Hospital at the main entrance on the east side of the complex. Additionally, Adams County Solid Waste offers small sharps containers available for \$5.00 and large sharps containers for \$10.00. This charge includes disposal.

<u>HAZARDOUS MATERIALS</u> - NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS ACCEPTED!!! A Hazardous Waste Collection is held every other summer at the Adams County Solid Waste site. Their next collection is scheduled for 2022 and local newspapers will announce the date. Empty latex paint cans and solidified latex pain is allowed for disposal **ONLY** if the paint is hard and dry.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

ABSOLUTELY NO SCAVENGING!!!

SOLID WASTE (Household Garbage): - Place in the compactor only, unless instructed by the attendant to use the miscellaneous container.

DO NOT LEAVE WASTE ON THE GROUND – Please ask for assistance if unable to get item(s) into an open-top dumpster and if all dumpsters are full, please bring back items when space is available in the dumpsters.

WOOD PRODUCTS - All wood products and other construction waste materials must be placed in the miscellaneous (open top) containers. No contractors or persons may deposit large amounts of debris without a permit. See the attendant for details.

YARD WASTE/COMPOST - LEAVES, GRASS CLIPPING, ETC. - Yard waste consists of leaves, pine needles, grass clippings and garden waste. Do not mix with any other items. Yard waste shall be free and clear of all plastics, stones, branches, plastic bags, etc. Yard waste will be accepted year-round on any day the Transfer Site is open. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE THE MATERIAL IN PLASTIC BAGS - EMPTY THE BAGS AND THROW THEM AWAY.

BATTERIES, OIL, ETC. - An area to dispose of used oil, oil filters, oil absorbents, automotive batteries and anti-freeze is provided. These items are accepted free of charge. The attendant will direct you to the proper location for these materials.

FEE ITEMS:

LIGHT BULBS - Under 4' florescent light bulbs - \$2.00 each. Over 4' florescent light bulbs - \$4.00 each.

MATTRESSES, RECLINERS & SOFAS - Crib/Twin \$10.00; all other sizes \$15.00. Box spring is considered a mattress. Recliner chairs, sofas and love seats are \$10.00 each, regardless of size.

APPLIANCES - An area to dispose of white goods – refrigerators, microwaves, stoves, washers, dryers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers is provided. You MUST check with the attendant BEFORE unloading appliances. The disposal fee is \$25.00 per item, including microwaves.

TIRES - The charge to dispose of tires without a rim is \$5.00 each; with a rim is \$10.00 each.

CEMENT, BLACKTOP, COMPUTERS AND ELECTRONICS (INCLUDING TELEVISIONS) – ARE NOT ACCEPTED AT THE TRANSFER SITE.

SPECIAL HOURS OF OPERATION – The Transfer Site is **CLOSED** on Easter Sunday and Christmas Day (when the holiday falls on a Wednesday, Saturday or Sunday). The Transfer Site is open on Memorial Day and Labor Day from 8:00 a.m. to Noon.
