## **Bounty for Pocket Gophers**

Pocket gophers are causing damage to fields and the equipment used in the fields.

Town of Sheridan will pay a bounty of \$1 for pocket gophers killed in the town of Sheridan by or for residents of Sheridan.

To receive payment the person claiming the bounty must cut the tail off the gopher and put the tails in a sealed air tight bag such that they can be counted without opening the bag. Said gophers must have been killed within the last 12 months. Neither residents nor anyone on the property where the gopher is killed may raise, rear or in any way harbor the gophers.

Each resident may submit no more than two claims per year. Claim is made by an affidavit form. Bounty payment will be mailed following the next board meeting.
