Award: \$500

Verification:

Graduating seniors from Stockbridge listed with the Rochester/Stockbridge Unified School District need not apply. Students from Stockbridge obtaining their GED may not be listed. If they are not, then documentation of Stockbridge residency and the GED is necessary before the award is dispersed.

Questions and Answers

1. Q: Do I need to apply to get this Graduate Award?

A: No, assuming your name is listed with the RSUSD as graduating from High School. If you are a Stockbridge resident and graduated this year and are not listed, you need to provide the Trustees with documentation of your residency and diploma or GED.

2. Q: Is there a family income limit to be eligible for this Award?

A: No.

3. Q: Is there any restrictions on how I spend my Award?

A: Not from the Trustees of Public Funds.

4. Q: I'm graduating this year and have younger siblings. Will they be eligible for a HS Graduate Award when they graduate?

A: Yes, if they live in Stockbridge when they graduate from High School or obtain their GED.

5. Q: Is there any requirement that I go on to a post-secondary program to receive this Award?

A: No.

6. Q: Do I need a certain grade-point average to receive this Award?

A: No. This Award is to recognize and honor your academic achievement and commitment by graduating from High School or obtaining your GED.
