RULES & REGULATIONS FOR WATER LINES

The following rules and regulations must be followed when placing a water service line in Sumpter Township. This list is not all inclusive but rather important rules of note. Please read the rules carefully, initial where indicated, then sign and date this form.

When you can install your service line

Your water line cannot be installed until after all permi	ts are received,	all fees paid	and until	the water	tap

the only person who can legally install a water service line in Sumpter Township is a Sumpter Township li- ensed water contractor or the homeowner him/her self. If you choose to do the work yourself please note that soil conditions and a very high water table in our area make this extremely difficult. If you do the work is a home owner you must do the work yourself with equipment under your physical operation and legal ontrol. The Township will allow family members who legally reside with you to assist but no one outside of our residence. Any work done by either persons not licensed or authorized through the Township will be in violation of Township Ordinances # 17 through # 17-0, as amended, and you will be fined accordingly. Inditionally the work will not be approved for service and the water will not be turned on for use. You must notify the Township Water Department of exactly who will be installing the water service line.

Acceptable Material
C-Copper tubing or plastic pipe is acceptable. If you use plastic pipe you must run a copper tracer wire with t for future pipe locating, should the need arise in the future. Plastic pipe must be rated at least 200 P.S.I.

Depth of Water Lines

All water service lines must be at least 5 feet deep from the established grade of the yard at the time of installation. Lines shallower than 5 feet may freeze during colder weather. A line installed any shallower than 5 feet will not be approved and your service will not be turned on for use.

Before you begin digging the trench for your water line you must call for your water line inspection. An inspector must be present for you to install your water line. Call a minimum of 3 days in advance to schedule an inspector. If the inspector is not present your line cannot be installed and will not be approved. After your line is approved your meter will be issued to you. You must call for a final inspection after the meter is installed and prior to the water being turned on. The earlier you call for these inspections the better.

Set Back Requirements (These items must be included on you plot plan)

All water lines must be installed on your property or on a legally recorded exclusive easement to your property for your sole use. They must be installed within a reasonable distance from any and all obstructions and in line to agree with the water tap alignment. Note the footage on the site plan for distance from the gas line, any other underground or overhead utilities and from the sewer or septic field and tank. A minimum horizontal separation from the septic absorption field of 20 feet is required. (A definition of a Septic Absorption Field as determined by The Wayne County Department of Public Health.) A minimum horizontal separation of 10 feet from all other utilities, hydrants, culverts and 15 feet from any trees, poles and bushes is also required.
