The Town Board of the Town of Dayton, Waupaca County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under Wis. Stat. §§ 349.11 and 346.57(4)(j) to adopt this ordinance.


This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting, and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of speed limits on certain town roads in the town as follows:


- A. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 349.11, effective August 18, 2020, speed limits on certain Town of Dayton town roads are reduced or modified as follows:
  - i. The speed limit on East Road from County Highway K to Spencer Lake Road will be reduced from 55 MPH to 45 MPH.
- B. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 349.11(5), the town chairperson, or his designee, shall place and maintain appropriate traffic signs at the above described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above described town roads in violation of the above described speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under Wis. Stat. § 346.60.

This ordinance is effective on September 15<sup>th</sup> 2020 or the date the 45 MPH signs are erected.

The town clerk shall publish this ordinance as required under Wis. Stat. § 60.80.
