## ORDINANCE NO. 2018-03 August 7, 2018

#### PENALTY PROVISIONS

The Albion Town Board of the Town of Albion of Dane County do ordain as follows:

- (1) GENERAL PENALTY. Unless another penalty is expressly provided in this Code, any persons who shall violate any of the provisions of this Code shall upon conviction of such violation be subject to a penalty, which shall be as follows:
- (a) FIRST OFFENSE, PENALTY. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Code subject to a penalty for which a penalty is not otherwise provided for in this code shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$50 nor more than \$200, together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such forfeitures and costs of prosecution may be imprisoned in the county jail for a period not exceeding 90 days, or may have their driver's license suspended or the court may impose any other penalty as provided by State Statute.
- (b) SECOND OFFENSE, PENALTY. Any person found guilty of violating any ordinance or any part of this Code who shall previously have been convicted of a violation of the same ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof forfeit not less than \$200 nor more than \$500 for each such offense together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs may be imprisoned in the county jail for a period not exceeding 6 months or may have their driver's license suspended or the court may impose any other penalty as provided by State Statutes.
- (c) CONTINUED VIOLATIONS. Each violation and each day a violation continues or occurs shall constitute a separate offense. Nothing in this Code shall preclude the Town of Albion from maintaining any appropriate action to prevent or remove a violation of any provision of this Code.
- (2) EXECUTION AGAINST DEFENDANT'S PROPERTY. Whenever any person fails to pay any forfeiture and costs of prosecution upon the order of the court for violation of any ordinance of the Town of Albion, the court may, in lieu of ordering imprisonment of the defendant, issue an execution against the property of the defendant for said forfeiture and costs.

### Section IX. Effective date

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after passage and publication or posting.
