

August 11, 2025 Regular Board Meeting

The Town of Bloomer regular monthly meeting was held on August 11, 2025 at the Bloomer Town Hall and was called to order by Chairman Gary Nehring at 7:00 pm.

Board Members present were: Gary Nehring, Brian Frion, Brian Lueck, Roxanne Geurkink and Ashley Nelson

Also in Attendance: Ray Buske, Gary Zwiefelhofer, Mike Paulson (Infinite Concrete) and Chuck Kouba (Senn Blacktop)

The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance.

No public comment.

All board members were provided a copy of the minutes of the July 8, 2025 Board meeting. Supervisor Lueck made a motion to approve the minutes. Chairman Nehring second the motion. Motion carried.

Receipts 8018 – 8026 were presented.

Checks 11663 - 11688 and 2 electronic transfers were presented.

Supervisor Lueck made a motion to approve the report and pay the bills. Supervisor Frion second the motion. Motion carried.

It has been noted that when the Town hall is rented, there are not enough chairs to set around all the tables. Chairman Nehring made a motion to purchase 24 more chairs at approximately \$30.00 each. Supervisor Frion second the motion. Motion carried.

Supervisor Lueck made a motion to book 2,800.00 gallons of propane with Chippewa Valley Energy at the price of \$1.519 per gallon. Supervisor Frion second the motion. Motion carried.

Senn Blacktop presented the proposal of some additional areas to be blacktopped to the south end of the shop and the east end of the sand and gravel bin to complete the parking lot project. A map of the areas and cost are attached and made a part of these minutes.

The Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) was signed. Clerk Geurkink will make sure that the County receives a copy of the plan.

The tractor/mower has not sold yet. The price will be dropped to \$12,500.00.

A complaint was received regarding demolition cars on property located on 150th. Chairman Nehring inspected the property and at that time the number of vehicles located on the property was within the specifications of the Town's ordinance.

Various mail items and correspondence were discussed.

The next Town Board Meeting will be Tuesday, September 9, 2025 and will begin at 7:00 pm.
