

## **December 9, 2025 Regular Board Meeting**

The Town of Bloomer regular monthly meeting was held on December 9, 2025 at the Bloomer Town Hall and was called to order by Chairman Gary Nehring at 7:00 pm.

Board Members present were: Gary Nehring, Brian Frion, Brian Lueck, Roxanne Geurkink and Ashley Nelson

The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance .

No public comment.

All board members were provided a copy of the minutes of the November 10, 2025 Regular Board Meeting and the Special Board Meeting held on November 12, 2025 and the Special Board Meeting held on December 3, 2025. The minutes were approved as follows:

Receipts 8050 – 8059 were presented.

Checks 11752 - 11775 and 2 electronic transfers were presented.

Chairman Nehring made a motion to approve the report with the revision that Ck #11763 in the amount of \$14,667.00 made payable to Senn Blacktop be voided and replaced with a check in the amount of \$12, 014.00 to Senn Blacktop. Supervisor Frion second the motion. Motion carried.

Supervisor Lueck made a motion to approve the budget presented for 2026. Supervisor Frion second the motion. Motion carried.

The Town's Association is asking that all Towns participate as members in the Town Advocacy Council (TAC). Chairman Nehring made a motion to participate in this program. Supervisor Frion second the motion. Motion carried. Clerk Geurkink will pay these dues in April, when the annual Town's Association dues are paid.

The renewal license applications were presented from Milestone Materials for the Webb Pitt and the Web Pitt Expansion. Supervisor Lueck made a motion to approve the renewal for the period of January 15, 2026 to January 15, 2027. Supervisor Frion second the motion. Motion carried.

Greg and Laurie Falkenburg presented a CSM for approval. The Falkenburgs discovered that their garage was too close to the property line, They then purchased a small piece a land from the neighbor to increase their property and create distance from the original property line. Supervisor Lueck made a motion to approve the CSM for the additional 4,697 square feet. Chairman Nehring second the motion. Motion carried.
