A RESOLUTION TEMPORARILY MOVING THE POLLING LOCATIONS FOR WARDS ONE AND TWO IN THE TOWN OF BOULDER JUNCTION FROM THE COMMUNITY CENTER TO THE FIRE STATION

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Boulder Junction, Vilas County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under Section 5.25 Wis. Statutes to move polling locations, provided that they comply with the notice requirements, which are summarized as follows:

A resolution must be passed by the Town Board at least 30 days in advance of the election, notice subsequently published in the newspaper, and posted in three prominent locations in the town.

WHEREAS, the Community Center is the permanent polling location for Wards One and Two for the Town of Boulder Junction; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Boulder Junction is a tourist town that seasonally offers many activities and functions at the Community Center; and

WHEREAS, the summer recall primary and general elections conflict with the previously committed use of the Community Center; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Station building is located within one block of the Community Center; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens and businesses of this community to move the polling locations for the remainder of 2011 in effort to sustain the economic wishility of this area and as previously committed
