The Town Board of Boulder Junction, and Town Plaza Steering Committee, are seeking participants for the Plaza Design Charrette. The Design Charrette event will take place over 2 nights, Thursday & Friday, January 12th and 13th, from 5:30-8:30 PM at the Boulder Junction Community Center. The Design Charrette process is created for the Public to have active and defining input into the key aspects of the Town Plaza design and functionality. Your participation is key.

While it would be beneficial to you and the process to attend both sessions, it is not necessary to attend both nights, or to attend the full 3 hour session. First and foremost we are requesting your participation at any level, using any of the methods provided. You are encouraged to attend in person if possible. If attendance is not possible, on-line input documents will be provided via the Town Website. This will allow any interested parties to provide valuable input into the process. If you re unable to attend, please monitor the Town Website for further information on how to participate in the process indirectly.

A brief agenda for the sessions is as follows:

- Night 1) We will first discuss the programming / usage aspects of the Plaza, and how that relates to attributes and features that will need to be considered in the design. Second objective for the night will be to settle on a primary site for the Plaza, using key influencing factors, including the programming discussion.
- Night 2) All in attendance will be randomly broken into teams with an objective of developing plaza design concepts using the programming and site related data form Night 1. At the end of the evening, each team will brief their concept to the attendees.

The Design Consultant will take the output from the Design Charrette, along with any other input received, and will develop 1-2 preliminary designs which will be presented to the Public at a future date, seeking additional input for refinement.

Due to the timing and length of the sessions, we are planning to have refreshments available for each night. Therefore, and RSVP to the Town Office would be appreciated if you are planning to attend, but it is not required. The meeting is open to all Town residents, landowners, and friends of Boulder Junction that love to live, work and play in our Town.
