How Much Speed Do I Really Need?

Businesses have symmetrical requirements - (ex. 100/100MB) and speeds over 1GB.

Here are some general download speed requirements based on everyday online activities:

- Check email and browse the web: 1-5 Mbps minimum
- Stream HD content: 15-25 Mbps minimum
- Stream 4K content and play competitive online games: 40-100 Mbps minimum
- Stream 4K content, play online games, and download very large files: 200+ Mbps
 minimum

The more connected devices, the more speed is required.







Orange zones signify new 100/10MB CenturyLink (CL) service (2 Nodes)


Option 2

Benefits

- Fiber (1GB+) to 53 parcels (High Speed Internet)
- New 100/10MB service district – 143 Parcels
- All parcels in blue service increase to 40/2MB+
