General Instructions, Presidential Preference Vote, School District, County. Includes sections for Democratic and Republican Party Primaries, and nonpartisan offices like County Supervisor.

Presidential Preference Vote begins at top of next column. Nonpartisan offices continue at top of next column. Continue voting on back of ballot.
