Review of the minutes from the November 18, 2025 budget meeting. Motion to approve minutes made by Christenson, seconded by Quandt. 3 ayes. Carried.

Treasurer Firgens explained the expenditures and receipts report showing a balance of \$111,201.35 in checking and \$163,436.28 in the money market.

Election Workers Ordinance- Explanation of need for ordinance for split shifts on election day and additional worker. Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-04 Election Day Split Shift and Additional Election Inspector made by Christenson, seconded by Quandt. 3 ayes. Approved.

Revise Appoint Clerk, Treasurer Ordinance- Revision to make referendum question for each office on the April 7th, 2026 Spring Election. Motion to accept the revised 2025-03

Ordinance Clerk/Treasurer Appointment made by A. Telford, seconded by Christenson. 3 ayes. Accepted.

Election Workers- Clerk Telford presented the board a list of election workers for 2026-2027 election cycle for the Town of Breed. All workers are unaffiliated. List includes Ahren Telford, Pam Nelson, Julia Timm, Pat Lewis, Ethel Firgens, Cindy Moran, Laurie Lucka, Jill Trochta, Marlene Thompson, Barb Hockers, and Kristen Telford. Motion to approve the election workers for the 2026-2027 election cycle made by Christenson, seconded by Quandt. 3 ayes. Approved.

Cemetery- Discussion on recent issues concerning burial placements and mapping system. Looking into software to track/map burials. Grave diggers have previously plowed cemetery only for winter burials. Thanks to Rich School who volunteered to plow entry and lane in cemetery.

Logan Rd- County couldn't complete the bridge project. Will finish next year. Stone under bridge is finished. Logan Rd crack filling will be completed next year. All other overlay projects completed. WISLR ratings are mostly done. Discussion on road rating segments.

Recycle Center- Recent issues with not enough dumpsters for trash. Price analysis of getting another trash dumpster. If becomes a frequent issue will address.

Updates/Correspondence- AED is back ordered. Coordinating with Gillett Ambulance to put together first aid kits. TC Energy requires a sign to recognize them for grant funding of equipment. Laurie Lucka volunteered to laminate a placard recognizing TC Energy. Room Tax Update: Town of Lakewood pulled out of Room Tax Commission. TEDCOR has budgeted funds to put towards tv tourism ads targeting main sources of tourism traffic.

Review made of the monthly bills. Motion to pay bills made by A. Telford, seconded by Christenson. 3 ayes. Carried.
