Meeting called to order at 6:00PM by Chairman Phil Christenson, reminder to silence phones. 10 electors present, no non-electors.

Pledge of allegiance.

Open meeting notices satisfied. Review of the agenda. Motion to approve agenda made by Dan Prouty, seconded by Brian Moran. Approved by majority vote. Motion carried.

Minutes from the 2025 Annual Electors meeting read. Approval of the minutes moved by Brian Moran, seconded by Laurie Lucka. Approved by majority vote. Motion carried.

Clerk Telford gave the 2025 financial report and explained the expenses and receipt amounts for the year. Motion to approve the financial report made by Laurie Lucka, seconded by Brian Moran. Approved by majority vote. Carried.

Cemetery- Town looking to redo road in cemetery with a turn around. Current road is rutted and washed out. Brush to be cut on north end by the field. Sumac to be sprayed after cutting. Jane School has new software and equipment to update records.

Road Report- Finishing Logan bridge a priority. Focus on fixing gravel roads. Discussion on overlays on Logan from Liss to Blue Rd or resurface if grinder is available. Blue Rd, N & S Pineview Circles are a priority. Limestone to be used because of better quality. Gravel hauling to be done by a contractor or the County. Town to do the grading. Discussion on rolling roads after gravel is down. Can do spot overlays to address problem areas. Discussion on giving back parts of Becker and Lasch to the County. Shouldering roads and intersections like Bonita and Peshtigo Brook. Town dump truck salter can be used for dispensing gravel for shouldering. Mike Koles from the Wisconsin Towns Association is working with Congressman Tony Weid to get our proposed CDL exemption for snowplowing town roads passed into law. Many emails sent to Congressman Weid. "ATV stay on pavement" signs to be placed on Bonita Rd. Tom, the town roadworker is off recovering from shoulder surgery and will be off for 5 weeks. Supervisors Quandt and Telford will be doing the work in his absence. Motion made to allow the Town Board to do road work deemed necessary made by Chris Hellem, seconded by Laurie Lucka. Approved by majority vote. Carried.

Discussion on how the town tax levy is figured out. Motion to allow the Town board to set the tax levy for the next year made by Brian Moran, seconded by James Telford. Approved by majority vote. Carried.

Motion to set the date and time of the 2027 Annual Elector Meeting for 6:00PM on Tuesday April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2027 made by Laurie Lucka, seconded by Phil Christenson. Approved by majority vote. Carried.

Motion to adjourn by Chris Hellem, seconded by Brian Moran. Approved by majority vote. Carried.
