

Town of Breed Regular Board Meeting Minutes

Tuesday June 9th, 2026 7:00PM

Meeting called to order by Chairman Phil Christenson at 7:00pm. Reminder to silence phones. Six electors and one non-electors in attendance.

Pledge of allegiance.

Roll Call: Chairman Christenson, Supervisors Mark Quandt and Ahren Telford, Treasurer Ethel Firgens, and Clerk Kristen Telford present.

Review of agenda. Open meeting notice statement. Motion to approve agenda by Quandt, seconded by A. Telford. Voted. Carried.

Review of minutes from May 12, 2026. Motion to approve minutes as written by A. Telford, seconded by Christenson. Voted. Carried.

Clerk's Correspondence: Review of reports done and upcoming reports, August State Primary election, referendum questions on the November 3rd ballots.

Treasurer's Report: Firgens gave expenditures and receipts for the month of May 2026 showing a balance of \$20,659.58 in checking and \$267,272.58 in the money market. Clerk and Treasurer balanced with the bank.

Public Comment: Questions about Tech College funds, data center moratorium, and Logan Bridge.

Cemetery: Sextant Jane School provided an updated version of the cemetery rules/regulations. Questions about degrading wooden crosses at cemetery. Comment that old/faded decorations can be removed and thrown away. Tabled until a finalized version of the cemetery rules/regulations are ready for the July meeting for approval.

Liquor Licenses: Completed applications submitted by 3 B Gun Club, Arrowhead Saloon, Pipeline 32, Salty Anchor, and Rhode's Oasis. Paperwork is in order, background checks showed no reason for denial. Motion to approve liquor licenses for the period of July 1st, 2026 to June 30th, 2027 by Christenson, seconded by Telford. Voted. Carried.

Road Report: Logan Bridge update covered in Public Comment. Snowstorm reimbursement paperwork should be finalized. Quandt evaluated S Branch Rd from Cherry Ln to Dale Missall's, approximately 7/10's of a mile for overlay paving. 3 culverts on S Branch sunken.

Discussion on overlaying sunken culvert sections. Quandt to get estimate from County for cost of overlays. Focus on graveling high traffic and damaged gravel roads such as but not limited to Pineview Circles and Blue Rd until road budget funds used up. Concerns about the leaning guardrail on Logan Rd. Discussion on graveling Logan Rd from Wild Turkey to Blue Rd.

Updates/Correspondence: Sheriff's report from the month of May showing incidents within the Town.

Review of the monthly bills. Discussion on adding contingency account. Motion to pay bills made by Christenson, seconded by Telford. Voted. Carried.
