

Town of Breed Regular Board Meeting Minutes

Tuesday September 8th, 2026 7:00PM

Breed Community Center 11155 State Hwy 32, Suring, WI 54174

Meeting called to order by Chairman Phillip Christenson. Reminder to silence phones. 11 electors and one visitor present.

Pledge of allegiance.

Roll Call: Chairman Christenson, Supervisors Mark Quandt and Ahren Telford, Treasurer Ethel Firgens, and Clerk Kristen Telford present.

Review made of agenda. Open meeting notice requirements met. Motion to approve the agenda as presented made by Telford, seconded by Quandt. Voted. Agenda approved.

Presentation of August 10, 2026 minutes. Motion to approve the minutes as written from August 10, 2026 regular board meeting made by Christenson, seconded by Quandt. Voted. Minutes approved.

Clerk Telford touched on election updates and explained referendum questions on November 3rd ballot.

Treasurer Firgens presented the expenditures and receipts for the month of August showing a balance of \$100,706.29 in checking and \$219,005.12 in the money market. Motion to approve the treasurer's report made by Quandt, seconded by Telford. Voted. Carried.

Public Comment: Question on the name of East Anderson Lake Dr vs East Anderson Lake Rd and signage. WISLR and tax roll say Drive not Road. Comment on gravel at corner of Harris and N Branch Rds.

Driveway/Culvert Permits: Don Meuleman's driveway shows no need for culvert but must follow the required dimensions of 24' wide at road tapered to 20' wide. Motion to approve Don Mueleman's driveway permit made by Telford, seconded by Quandt. Voted. Approved. Review of Michael and Renee Rusch's driveway/culvert. Lowered ground level by roadway requires a culvert under the driveway. Must also follow the requirements of 24" wide at roadside tapering to 20', 18" culvert of 24' in length. Motion to approve Michael and Renee Rusch's driveway/culvert permit with the stated requirements made by Christenson, seconded by Telford. Voted. Approved.

Plan Commission: Barb Hockers term lapsed; looking to renew position. Barb in agreement. Motion to renew Barb Hockers appointment on Breed's Plan Commission made by Telford, seconded by Christenson. Voted. Carried.

Website Update: TownWeb is company who hosts our town website offered an update to our website page layout. 3 different versions presented. Discussion on which version works/looks best for our application. "Village of Juniper" example chosen. Motion to accept the "Village of Juniper" example for the town website design made by Christenson, seconded by Quandt. Voted. Accepted.

Cemetery: Chairman has access to a 3pt backblade to smooth out the driveway better. Is donating a new sign box for at the cemetery to display rules and regulations. Jane School getting into the Cryptkeeper program.

Recycle Center: Getting compliments on how the recycle center is run.

Breed Family Park: Issues with trash needing to be picked up before mowing, garbage barrels thrown out on lawn, ruts in left field from UTVs/ATVs. Discussion on signage "no parking on ballfield". Board will contact Arrowhead Saloon owner about issues with garbage and damage.

Community Center Cleaning: Cindy Moran offered to clean hall for \$/hr. Motion to bring Cindy on as Community Center Cleaner at \$10/hr made by Christenson, seconded by Telford. Voted. Approved.

Road Report: Guard rail on Logan still not done. Oconto Co. was contacted about issue. Quandt will contact Brandon about it again. Mark Quandt presented work done on N&S Pineview Circles and Big Eddie Ln. 37 loads of limestone hauled by Thompson Excavating. All 3 roads graveled for under \$10,000. Overlays done on S Branch from Cherry to Van Cassel and half mile on Wendt from 32 to just past Wright Ln. Still want to do overlay on first corner of Bonita Rd. Discussion on water issues on inside corner. Also overlay on Logan by Pipeline Bar and on Central by trail crossing. More gravel needed on Mayer and N Mayer. Discussion on ditching south side of Erb Ln to shed water to culvert instead of running across the road.

Updates/Correspondence: Suring Fire Department activity for the month of August. No Sheriff's report. North Branch parcel update-parcel belongs to Donald Becker and Family. Owner has no interest in selling it.

Review of monthly bills. Motion to pay bills made by Telford, seconded by Christenson. Voted. Carried.
