

# RESOLUTION NO. 2013-0225

## ADOPTING A ROAD SIGN POLICY FOR ROAD SIGNS ON TOWN PROPERTY

TOWN OF CALEDONIA, COLUMBIA COUNTY, WISCONSIN

**Whereas,** The 1993 DOT appropriations act established minimum retro-reflectivity standards for road signage and markings for public roads within the State of Wisconsin; and,

**Whereas,** The Wisconsin Department of Transportation has directed that officials having jurisdiction over road signage shall use an assessment or management method designed to maintain sign retro-reflectivity at or above these minimum standards; and,

**Whereas,** The Town of Caledonia has drafted a road sign evaluation and replacement policy; and

**Whereas,** This policy is intended to meet the above stated requirements for sign retro-reflectivity maintenance.

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved,** By the Town Board of Caledonia, Columbia County; that the attached policy be and is hereby adopted by the Town.
