Postings in three public places were verified.

Secretary's Report was read. Motion to approve by Steve Strey with a second by Mike Klotz.

Road Issues:

- Culvert on Railroad St in Allen has been replaced.
- Board should look at culvert on Canary and see if it needs replacement. Dennis Judd cleaned it.
- Culvert on W Robin needs to be looked at before Monarch begins their work
- Culvert on Wren caved in – suggested to put some blacktop on it for now
- Three trees down in Bunting/W Robin area after storm. Mike Klotz, Lotty Macik, and Menno Otten took care of clearing the roadway.
- New blades were ordered for the brush mower
- Tree was cut down on Marshall by Norm Abley residence

New Business:

Motion to approve these licenses by Lotty Macik with a second by Steve Strey. Motion carried.
- A complaint has been issued by Bill Berger about a line fence with Dennis Judd. Discussion followed. The board will look into the matter.

Old Business:

- The Old Museum Contract should be renewed/rewritten. Table to next meeting
- Lotty Macik was concerned about Tony Brooks residing the old town hall. Tony understood his concerns but reassured him he would get the job done.
- Acoustic panels need to be put up. Motion by Lotty Macik with a second by Steve Strey to have Tony Brooks install the panels.
