To Approve the Highway Superintendent's Sale of a 1993 Elgin Pelican Sweeper

WHEREAS, the Highway Superintendent has determined that a certain 1993 Elgin Pelican Sweeper (the "Equipment") owned by the Town is no longer needed by the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Highway Superintendent seeks Town Board approval to declare such Equipment as surplus and to authorize the Highway Superintendent to dispose of such Equipment by sale at auction; now, therefore,

It is hereby **RESOLVED**, that the Town Board declares that the Equipment is surplus equipment that is no longer needed by the Town; and


It is hereby **FURTHER RESOLVED**, that pursuant to Highway Law § 142(5), the Town Board approves the Highway Superintendent's request that he be permitted to sell the Equipment at auction.
