## Resolution No. 2023-07 Amending the Town of Dakota 2023 Budget

WHEREAS, since the development of the 2023 budget nearly a year ago, unanticipated revenues and expenses have occurred that must be reflected in the budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Dakota Town Board that the following amendments be made to the 2023 budget:

- \$900 be added to the Public Charges revenue account, due to more than anticipated town hall rentals and mobile home street light fees, with a corresponding \$500 added to the Buildings & Grounds expense account, and \$400 added to the Public Works/Street Lights expense account; and
- \$22,650 be transferred from the Reserve/Contingency Fund to the following expense accounts:
  - \$400 to the General Administration expense account due to unbudgeted machine firmware fees and the timing of the county's Fall 2022 election billing;
  - \$50 to the Financial Administration expense account due to an increased cost in assessment software;
  - \$3,500 to the Buildings and Grounds expense account to cover unbudgeted expenses for: abandoning an outdoor well and other plumbing costs, stripping/ waxing floors, installing a flag light, replacing the door lock, and higher than anticipated monthly security monitoring costs;
  - \$1,700 to the Other General Government account to cover necessary financial software and WiFi updates, as well as unexpected failed lottery credits.
  - \$17,000 to the Highway Maintenance expense account due to higher-than average snowplowing and tree removal costs in 2023;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this addendum has zero effect on the 2023 tax levy;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as required by law, this resolution was adopted by a twothirds majority vote of the entire membership of the Town Board.
