

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
MARCH 9, 2026
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor and Fire Chief Chad Degal, Supervisor Hopfensperger, Treasurer Sheri Wilkins, Clerk Jenny Hunt, and residents present.

No public input.

No Outagamie Sheriff was present.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to approve a certified survey map for Bob Valentine, seconded by Chairperson Wunderlich, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a plat for Bob Valentine, seconded by Supervisor Hopfensperger, motion carried. The plat was reviewed at the March 2, Planning Commission meeting.

The Board considered a request for a Special Exception for Sunvest Solar Farm. A public hearing was held prior to the meeting. Board members expressed that, as elected officials, it is important to listen to the residents who live near the proposed site. Following discussion, each member voted against the proposal. Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to deny the Special Exception request and to recommend to Outagamie County that the request not be approved, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a one-year contract with Central Temp for yearly maintenance on the HVAC system in the municipal building and fire hall, seconded by Supervisor Hopfensperger, motion carried.

Nick Hurst and Luke Haase from DMR Softball presented the idea for a softball storage building in Daufen Park for them to store their leagues equipment. Discussion took place. They were advised to come back with formal plans and insurance questions were raised.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a request for a Tobacco License for Old Station 31 Spirits, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried. Supervisor Hopfensperger abstained.

The Gold Cross operational update was tabled.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a bartender's license for Marie Kahler, Wally's Still provided all paperwork and fees are submitted, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to approve a request by 4-DK Farms for a holding tank variance, seconded by Supervisor Hopfensperger, motion carried.

Chris Koga made a request to use Daufen Park for the 127th Infantry Retirement Association picnic on June 20th. Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion, seconded by Supervisor Degal, to waive all fees for the June 20th rental.

Fire Chief Degal reported eighteen calls for the month of February; sixteen EMS calls, one car accident and one farm accident.

Fire Chief Degal reported that the department members voted to purchase an EMS vehicle. The vehicle will be funded through fundraising efforts, including raffles such as the annual fireworks raffle. The department's goal

is to purchase and fully equip the vehicle for approximately \$150,000. Chief Degal indicated the intent is to purchase a Ford F-350 truck, which would be used for EMS calls in place of deploying a full-sized fire truck.

Two building permits were issued in the month of February; n no new homes.

The planning commission met and reviewed both a certified survey map and plat for Bob Valentine. The commission also reviewed a solar farm request for Hwy 96 and Hwy 45.

Chairperson Wunderlich reported that snow plowing was going well this season. Once snow plowing is complete, they will begin filling potholes as needed. At this time, no major road projects have been finalized. School Road west of the railroad tracks is being considered as a possible project.

Supervisor Hopfensperger made a motion to approve the minutes of the February meeting, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Open Book is currently scheduled for April 20th and Board of Review is scheduled for May 11, 2026, 5:00pm – 7:00pm.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Hopfensperger, motion carried.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills #21626 - 21651, seconded by Chairperson Wunderlich, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.
