

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
AUGUST 10, 2026
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor and Fire Chief Chad Degal, Supervisor Hopfensperger, Treasurer Sheri Wilkins, Clerk Jenny Hunt, and residents present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

During public input, a resident was present and expressed concerns regarding the condition of several properties and properties with unlicensed vehicles within the Town, primarily along State Road 96. The resident asked whether there are any ordinances or other measures available to the Town that would require property owners to clean up and maintain these properties. The Board discussed the resident's concerns.

Outagamie County Deputy Delvoye was present and reported that several traffic stops were conducted along State Highway 96 for speeding during the past month. Deputy Delvoye also discussed reports of a possible homeless individual sleeping in a vehicle behind area businesses, between the businesses and the railroad tracks. Deputy Delvoye stated that he would look into the reports further.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the veteran's reimbursement for Dale Union Cemetery, Pine Grove Cemetery, and South Medina Cemetery, seconded by Supervisor Hopfensperger, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve Dale, Medina, Readfield Softball's use of the Daufen Park baseball diamond on August 21 from 2:00p.m. to 10:00p.m. for a tournament with Bear Creek for 9 to 11 year-olds, and to approve a temporary beer license for the event, provided all required paperwork and fees are completed, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

The owners of a property on Midway Road were present to discuss garden structures they had constructed on their property. Chairperson Wunderlich informed the property owners that the building inspector had reviewed the project and determined that a building permit would be required if the total cost of the project cost reaches \$5000.

Chairperson Wunderlich motioned to approve a bartender's license for Alexander Pettey at Jimmer's provided all paperwork and fees are completed, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Fire Chief Degal reported nineteen calls for the month of July; twelve EMS calls, two car accidents, one house fire, one for power lines down, one for smoke smell and two to assist with storm damage in Fox Crossing.

Eight building permits were issued in the month of July; no new homes.

The planning commission did not meet this month. Because Labor Day falls on the first Monday of the month in September, if needed the Planning Commission meeting will be rescheduled to Tuesday, September 8th.

Roads Report:

- The one-mile section of School Road has been paved and shouldered.
- Coal patching throughout Town continues and the second round of ditch mowing is underway.
- New London Tree Service removed two trees, and Chairperson Wunderlich removed several trees from the municipal building grounds.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to approve the minutes of the July meeting, seconded by Supervisor Hopfensperger, motion carried.

The Partisan Primary Election will be held tomorrow, August 11, 2026. Polls will be open from 7:00a.m. – 8:00p.m.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Hopfensperger, motion carried.

Supervisor Hopfensperger reported that there may be grant funding available through the State to assist municipalities with the removal of dead ash trees. The Town will look into potential grant opportunities and eligibility requirements.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills #21823 - 21898 seconded by Supervisor Hopfensperger, motion carried.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Chairperson Wunderlich, motion carried.
