Town of Dane, Dane County Wisconsin Resolution 2017-10-02-1

Supporting Immediate Upgrade of the Town of Dane Broadband Infrastructure and Access

Whereas, The Town of Dane has a responsibility to assist its citizens in securing the essential services for daily life, including broadband (phone and internet); and

Whereas, reliable wired phone service is essential for communication of all types, especially emergency services; and

Whereas, improved broadband is necessary to all citizens for education, health care, communication, interactions with government, farming and business operations, entertainment, commerce and future uses yet to be developed; and

Whereas, the need for broadband service is growing daily; and

Whereas, most citizens of the Town of Dane lack the current Wisconsin PSC benchmark speed of 25 Mbps down/3 Mbps up. (Source: PSC Broadband maps); and

Whereas, Town residents' surveys, and inquiries to the Town Board reveal that Town residents find their broadband speeds and access to be non-existent, poor or inadequate; and

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin budget recently signed by Gov. Walker incudes \$14,000,000 for PSS Broadband Expansion Grants; and

Whereas; the rural areas of Wisconsin and the Town of Dane should have access to the benchmark minimum standard of 25/3 wired connectivity.

Be it resolved, that the duly elected officials of the Town of Dane support the Broadband Expansion grant proposal to the Wisconsin PSC from the TDS/Waunakee Telephone Company for portions of the Town of Dane that are served by TDS, and requests that the PSC make this application a top priority.

Be it resolved, that the Town of Dane requests TDS consider the possibility of expanding broadband service to areas of the Town not currently served by TDS.

Be it resolved, that the Town of Dane Board will cooperate with TDS in its efforts to expand and upgrade broadband infrastructure in the Town of Dane, and offer assistance where possible.

Be it finally resolved, that this resolution be submitted to TDS Telecom, the PSC, other interested parties, and pertinent State of Wisconsin elected officials.
