Town of Dane, Dane County Wisconsin Ordinance 2022-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF DANE TO ALLOW FOR THE SELECTION OF 2 OR MORE SETS OF ELECTION OFFICIALS TO WORK AT DIFFERENT TIMES ON ELECTION DAY.

WHEREAS the Town of Dane and the Town Clerk and/or Deputy Clerk are responsible for the conduct and integrity of all elections held in the Town, and

WHEREAS the Town of Dane Board appoints Election Inspectors to work the various elections held within the Town; and

WHEREAS the Town of Dane Board desires that when necessary shifts be established allowing two or more sets of Election Inspectors to work at the polls on Election Day.

Now, therefore, The Town Board of the Town of Dane, Dane County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 7.30 (1) the Town of Dane shall allow for the selection of two or more sets of election officials to work at different times on election days and permit the Clerk, Deputy Clerk or designee to establish different working hours for different officials assigned to the same polling place. Officials shall also be appointed in a number sufficient to maintain adequate staffing of the polling place. No fewer than 3 Election Inspectors, one of which must be a Chief Election Inspector, shall be appointed for each shift.
- 2. Pursuant to § 7.30(3)(a), Wis. Stats., the Clerk and Deputy Clerk, as well as the election inspectors, are authorized to act as tabulators in any election.
