## Town of Dane, Dane County, Wisconsin Resolution 2022-01

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN CLERK, DEPUTY CLERK OR DESIGNEE TO DETERMINE THE NUMBER OF ELECTION OFFICIALS THAT WILL BE REQUIRED TO WORK AT ELECTIONS CONDUCTED IN THE TOWN OF DANE

**WHEREAS** the Town of Dane and the Town Clerk and Deputy Clerk are responsible for the conduct and integrity of all elections held in the Town and the expenses thereof; and

WHEREAS the Town of Dane Board appoints Election Inspectors to work the various elections held within the Town; and

WHEREAS the Town of Dane desires to control expenses by using only the manpower necessary to conduct an election; and

WHEREAS Wis. Stat. § 7.30 (1) states that the governing body of the municipality may reduce the number of election inspectors to 5 where voting machines are used; and

WHEREAS Wis. Stat. § 7.32. states that notwithstanding § 7.30 (1), the governing body of the municipality may reduce by resolution the number of election inspectors to be used. However, no polling place may have fewer than three election inspectors, one of which must be a Chief Election Inspector.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Board of the Town of Dane that the Town Clerk, Deputy Clerk or designee is authorized to determine the number of election officials to be used at each election in the Town of Dane within the guidleines as determined by the Wisconsin Statutes.
