

Recycling and Trash Disposal Provisions Town of Dane Residents Only

Recyclables and Trash. The Town of Dane contracts with Tim's Trucking for pickup of trash and recyclables for **Town of Dane Residents Only** at our Recycling and Separation Center on Hyslop Rd. Separate large containers will be used to collect recyclables (acceptable for single stream collection) and non-recyclable trash (unacceptable for single stream collection). You should dispose of your recyclables (acceptable for single stream collection) and non-recyclable trash in the proper container at the recycling center on designated collection time and dates, most Saturday mornings from 8 am to noon. Holidays that affect trash and recycling pick up include New Years Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas. Extra hours in Summer may be available. You do not have to sort your recyclables. You can mix them together. They will be sorted and separated using 'single stream recycling' methods. To the greatest extent practicable, recyclables should be clean and kept free of contaminants such as food or product residue, oil and grease. **Do not place non-recyclable materials and trash in the recycling container, including but not limited to household hazardous waste, medical waste, agricultural chemicals or their containers, Styrofoam, and foam insulation. If you use bags for recycling they must be clear plastic. You may also place recyclables in open cardboard boxes. All items you are recycling must be visible to the attendant.**

Burning and burnable waste-only. Unpainted and unfinished wood and brush are allowed for incineration. Wood should be clear of nails, all metal and other non-wood materials. Do not bring furniture or unclean/unpainted construction debris to be burned. We do not burn paper or cardboard (cut, flatten, bind with tape/twine and place in in recycling container).

Bulky and oversized items. The town will no longer accept refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or any other appliances. Keep this in mind when buying new appliances. Other bulky and oversized items including sofas, recliners, mattresses and other large furniture will not be accepted at the Hyslop Road collection site, except on Spring Clean-up Day. **Small amounts of remodeling materials such as windows and construction debris are allowed in the trash container, but large amounts are not accepted.** A Clean-up Day each spring will allow **Town of Dane** residents to bring bulky items, furniture, appliances, tires, and other items (a fee may be charged). Automotive-Tires/Oil/Antifreeze will not be accepted. Used oil filters are now accepted.

"Dane County Clean Sweep" is a program designed to lower the environmental risks associated with improper disposal of hazardous materials. For a nominal fee, residents of Dane County may use this program to safely dispose of unwanted paint, chemicals and other hazardous materials found in their homes. Businesses may also be eligible to participate.
