

RESOLUTION #7-2022

WEAPON DISCHARGE ON RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, no person, other than a police officer or other law enforcement officer in the performance of an official duty, may discharge or fire any weapon on property that is zoned and utilized as residential land, and

WHEREAS, "notwithstanding any provision of Section 9.02 2) (a) to the contrary, the Town Board or its designee may, upon written application demonstrating good cause and upon such terms and conditions as it may prescribe as to time, place, and circumstance, suspend the enforcement of said paragraph." Section 9.02 3).

WHEREAS, Jeremy Renz, 4490 CTH O North (#FA313900001), has made application to allow discharge of a firearm on his property zoned Conservancy-Residential (C-3). The closest neighboring property owner (4482 CTH O North - #FA313900002) has signed a permission letter and the property is surrounded by Agricultural zoned property on the 3 other sides of the parcel, and

WHEREAS, the following restrictions would apply:

1. No discharge of a weapon prior to 9:30am or after 6:00pm, except for hunting purposes.
2. No consecutive days of discharging a weapon
3. No shooting would exceed 6 hours in length on any given day
4. No fully automatic firearms would be discharged
5. No ammunition would be used that would not be stopped by a reasonable backstop such as a 50-caliber round, cannon, or punt gun

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board suspends the enforcement of Section 9.02 2) (a) to allow discharge of a weapon on residential property at 4490 CTH O North (#FA313900001).

RESOLUTION #8-2022


LAKEFEST DAY CHANGE
