RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE CHANGE OF BARGAINING UNIT REPRESENTATION FOR THE TOWN OF DELAVAN PROFESSIONAL POLICE ASSOCIATION

Whereas: as evidenced by the attached Exhibit A, the members of the Town of Delavan Professional Police Association bargaining unit (Association) wish to change their exclusive bargaining representative as the Labor Association of Wisconsin (LAW) their current representative has given notice that they wish to discontinue representing these members and wind down their business; and,

Whereas: the Association has unanimously asked the Town to voluntarily recognize changing their exclusive bargaining representative to the Wisconsin Professional Police Association (WPPA); and

Whereas: the LAW has confirmed that it has no objection to the Town proceeding to approve another exclusive bargaining representative effective November 11,2025; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Delavan, that effective November 11, 2025 the Town voluntarily recognizes the Wisconsin Professional Police Association - Law Enforcement Employee Relations division as the exclusive bargaining representative for the law enforcement public safety bargaining unit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Agreement Between the Town of Delavan and the Town of Delavan Professional Police Association (Agreement) be and is hereby amended such that any and all references to LAW shall hereafter refer to WPPA, particularly the preamble of the Agreement, that is hereby repealed and recreated to read: "This Agreement made and entered into by the Town of Delavan, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as the Employer, and the Wisconsin Professional Police Association - Law Enforcement Employee Relations, hereinafter referred to as the Association."
