Ordinance 2022-8

Town of Gibson, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE OFFICE OF TOWN CLERK-TREASURER

The Town Board of the Town of Gibson, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.30(1e)(a), the office of town Clerk-Treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the town board

The term of office for the appointed position shall be set by the town board, but may not exceed 3 years per § 60.30(1e)(c). The town board may re-appoint the officer for additional terms. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for "cause" as defined under § 17.001 and required by § 60.30(1e)(f).

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on November 8, 2022. The referendum question shall be:

"Shall the person holding the office of town Clerk-Treasurer in the Town of Gibson, Manitowoc County be appointed by the town board?"

The level of compensation of the appointed position shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its publication and/or posting, per the terms of Wis. Stat. § 60.80, and its referendum approval by the town electors as required by § 60.30(1e)(b).
