ARTICLE I
Wisconsin Public Service Corporation
[Adopted 8-16-1990 by Ord. No. 140]

§ A335-1. Grant of authority to sell gaseous fuel.

In accordance with the provisions of § 196.58(6), Wis. Stats., the Wisconsin Public Service Corporation, its successors and assigns, is hereby authorized to distribute and sell gaseous fuel, natural, manufactured, or mixed, for heat, power, light and other purposes in the Town of Goodman, Marinette County, Wisconsin.

§ A335-2. Use of public highways.

In accordance with the provisions of § 86.16(1), Wis. Stats., permission and authority are hereby granted to said Wisconsin Public Service Corporation to construct, install, lay, operate, maintain, extend, improve and add to mains, pipes, and other facilities for the purpose of transmitting and delivering such gas along, across, in, and within the limits of any public highway, street, alley, sidewalk, public ground, and all other places under control of said Town of Goodman, and to that end said Wisconsin Public Service Corporation shall have the right to take up such pavements and to make such excavations as may be necessary to lay, take up, repair and maintain gas pipes below the surface of the ground.

§ A335-3. Facilities.

Permission and authority are hereby granted to said Wisconsin Public Service Corporation to construct, install, operate, maintain, extend, improve and add to such buildings, plants, equipment, properties, apparatus and other facilities as may be necessary to receive, manufacture, store, transmit, distribute and sell such gas.

§ A335-4. Conditions.

Authority granted herein is subject to all conditions and provisions of the statutes of the State of Wisconsin on such case made and provided.

§ A335-5. Damages.

Any damage caused to public installations by reason of said construction, operation, maintenance and extension shall be repaired within a reasonable time by the Wisconsin Public Service Corporation.

Chapter 179

FIREARMS AND WEAPONS

§ 179-1. Carrying and discharge.

§ 179-3. Violations and penalties.

§ 179-2. Throwing or shooting of arrows,
stones and other missiles.

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Goodman 4-6-1960 by Ord. No. 112; amended in its entirety at time of adoption of Code (see Ch. 1, General Provisions, Art. I). Subsequent amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 179-1. Carrying and discharge.

- A. No person shall carry upon his person any firearm within the Town of Goodman unless such firearm is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case.
- B. No person shall carry any firearm inside any public building within the Town of Goodman.
- C. No person shall shoot, fire, or discharge any firearm, air gun, pellet gun, paint ball gun, BB gun, slingshot or bow and arrow within the Town of Goodman.
- D. Subsection A and B above shall not apply to:
 - (1) Any law enforcement officer in the performance of his duties.
 - (2) Members of the armed forces when on duty.
 - (3) Any government employee authorized or required by his employment or office to carry firearms.
 - (4) Any person having a valid permit issued to him by lawful authority to carry or use firearms.
 - (5) The use of blank cartridges by individuals and organizations approved by the County Sheriff.
 - (6) Private property.
- E. The prohibition in Subsection C above on the discharge of air guns, pellet guns, paint ball guns, BB guns, slingshots, or bows and arrows shall not apply when such discharge is done on private property with the permission of the property owner, under the supervision and in the presence of an adult, and where the projectile does not leave the private property where such discharge is being conducted.

§ 179-2. Throwing or shooting of arrows, stones and other missiles.

No person shall throw or shoot any object, arrow, stone, iceball or other missile or projectile, by hand or by any other means, at any person or at, in or into any building, street, sidewalk, alley, highway, park, playground or other public place within the Town of Goodman.

§ 179-3. Violations and penalties.

Any person guilty of violation of any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$50 together with costs of said action and, in default of the payment thereof, to be imprisoned in the county jail of Marinette County until such forfeiture and subsequent costs have been paid, but not to exceed 60 days.
