June 2017

Highlights of Town Board Meetings

March 20:

♦ The Town of Goodman applied for a grant from the M&M Community Area Foundation and was awarded a \$750 grant to continue working on the area surrounding the Veterans' Monument, which would include a new sign and benches. Paula



Grusyznski, Executive Director of M&M Community Area Foundation, was at the board meeting to present the \$750 check, and a picture was taken of the board members and the American Legion commander.

- Armstrong Creek would like the expense report for the Fire Department broken down by individual amounts.
- The road maintenance crew is brushing roads and checking the need for patching and/or wedging. A vendor from Iron River is being considered for chip sealing.
- ♦ The old town truck is in need of repairs costing approximately \$6,000. The town will continue using the truck until summer and then consider options.
- Marinette County may be donating money toward the Florence County broadband service.

April 18:

Annual Meeting:

- ♦ The minutes of the 2016 annual meeting were available for everyone to read. They were then approved.
- ♦ The financial statement was reviewed by everyone present and all questions were answered.
- The town board stated that new "Welcome to Goodman" signs will be ordered.
- A question was asked about the access lot to Lake Hilbert. The answer was: "It is Albert Goodman's land and it is up to him to decide what to do about it."
- The annual meeting next year will be on April 17, 2018.

Regular Meeting:

- Marinette County Economic Development is proposing three new towers in Florence County be built to provide high speed broadband servicer. They are asking the town of Goodman for a \$500 pledge to help cover the cost. No action was taken, but it will be brought up at next month's meeting.
- An ordinance amending Chapter 140 was approved by the board that building permits are required on construction of new overnight camping units in a campground. If the town does not make this change, the State will do it.
- ◆ No patching or chip sealing material is available yet. May 22:
- An insurance agent from Horton Ins. Co. gave a presentation on their insurance policy. The Town of Goodman has had a policy with Horton for many years. The town board will review this proposal and decide whether to accept it at a later date.
- A motion was made and approved to pledge \$500 to Marin atte County's proposed high-speed broadband towers.

- The town of Goodman has completed a 26-page employees' handbook. Motion was made and approved to adopt this handbook.
- Goodman Township Park at Lake Hilbert will be opened Memorial Day weekend.
- ♦ The Goodman Historical Society announced they will be sponsoring "Music in the Park" in the area of the historical building on Wednesday evenings during the summer (if weather permits). If enough talented people volunteer, there will be a performance every Wednesday at 7 p.m. If not, it will be every other Wednesday. Call Joan Flannery at 715-336-2495 to confirm dates. Anyone wishing to perform music should call Joan. To ensure a place to sit, bring lawnchairs.
