Town of Grant. Portage County, Wisconsin

RESOLUTION to support the Mertz Subdivision project identified in Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Safe Route to School (SRTS) Application

WHEREAS, the Town of Grant of Portage County, WI (hereafter referred to as Town of Grant) recognizes the benefits of multimodal transportation choices for its residents and visitors such as bicycle and pedestrian options; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Grant supports the TAP SRTS application prepared for the 2024-2028 award cycle. The application is to develop a bicycle and pedestrian transportation plan for the Mertz Subdivision affecting 80 residential homes and adjacent to Grant Elementary School, (a 4K-5th grade facility with 267 students), a softball sports complex and a school forest; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Grant recognizes that WisDOT reimburses project sponsors for the federal share of the approved TAP SRTS project costs, up to the limit of the 80% federal award amount. In view of the 20% minimum match requirement, the Town shall secure matching funds from its own budget, and if feasible, other public-private partnerships; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, if the Town of Grant is awarded funding by WisDOT for the 2024–2028 TAP SRTS award cycle, the Town is authorized to and agrees to accept the award and enter into all necessary agreements with WisDOT for the above-referenced project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town of Grant agrees to comply with all applicable laws, requirements, and regulations as outlined in the WisDOT 2024–2028 TAP SRTS application materials, the state-municipal agreement between WisDOT and the Town of Grant, and any other programs and/or project documentation.


