TOWN OF GRANT PORTAGE COUNTY WISCONSIN ORDINANCE NO. 2024-1

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE TOWN OF GRANT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF GRANT, PORTAGE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 62.23(2) and (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Grant is authorized to prepare and amend a Comprehensive Plan for the Town of Grant as defined in Section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 2. The Town Board, by the enactment of an ordinance, formally adopted an amendment to Town of Grant Comprehensive Plan, titled "Town of Grant, Comprehensive Plan 2018," on November 27, 2018.

SECTION 3. The Plan Commission, by a majority vote of the Commission at a meeting held on December 20, 2023, adopted a resolution approving an Amendment and recommending adoption of an Amendment by the Town Board to the Town of Grant 2018 Comprehensive Plan to add additional requirements to the Solar Overlay Map and text to direct future large scale solar projects 100 MW or greater to areas that best fit overall future land use visions.

SECTION 4. The Town published a Class 1 public notice in compliance with the requirements of Section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes, and held a public hearing on February 14, 2024 to obtain public comments regarding the comprehensive plan amendment.

SECTION 5. The Town Board hereby adopts this Ordinance as an amendment to the 2018 Town of Grant Comprehensive Plan.

SECTION 6. The Town Clerk is directed to send a copy of the plan update to the parties listed in Section 66.1001(4)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the full membership of the Town Board.
