

**ORDINANCE 2024-2**

Portage County

The Town Board of the Town of Grant, Portage County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.07 (8), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.


This ordinance, adopted by the majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the installation of stop signs on town highways in the town as follows:

- A. Stop signs shall be placed on 90<sup>th</sup> Street South in the town at each entrance of that road onto Mill Road.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall erect stop signs as provided in this ordinance on or before the effective date of this ordinance\*.

This ordinance is effective on March 31, 2024.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80, Wis. Stats.
